



OUR SERVICE DELIVERY MODELS





Clinical Outreach Team (COT)

A fully staffed and equipped team providing a full range (spacing, long-acting reversible and permanent methods) of family planning choices to clients in public sector sites.



Mini-Clinical Outreach Team (Mini-COT)

Reaching out to young adults closer to where they live and providing them with information, counselling and family planning services (spacing and long-acting reversible methods).



Marie Stopes Clinic

A one-stop facility offering an entire range of high quality family planning and reproductive health services in Ajmer, Jaipur, Banswara, Bareilly, Gaya and Saharsa.



Public Sector Support (PSS)

Improving choices and quality of family planning services for clients in identified public sector sites in Rajasthan.

STORIES FROM THE GROUND



Going Beyond the Call of Duty

Our women colleagues often encounter patriarchal notions and mindsets while delivering services in rural areas. Tanuja, one of our Mini-COT counsellors, experiences this every day while reaching out to the most vulnerable and neglected communities in Bihar.

She once met a client who wanted to space her next pregnancy. Tanuja provided her with the required information and counselling and the client chose to have an Intra Uterine Contraceptive Device (IUD) inserted. Subsequently, Tanuja was confronted by the client's husband who demanded to have it removed. Despite her best efforts, Tanuja could not convince the client's husband. Tanuja didn't lose hope. She started visiting the family

regularly and finally made the husband realise the benefits of family planning. Tanuja's grit and determination helped the client get the contraception she wanted. She has become a 'figure of hope and courage' among her team members, regularly going beyond the call of duty to ensure the delivery of crucial family planning services.

Male-engagement in Family Planning

Ahmed, a rickshaw puller from Sitamarhi district of Bihar had quite a dramatic day when he got his Non Scalpel Vasectomy (NSV) done. He came riding his rickshaw, much to the worry of the COT team, as they did not want him to ply the rickshaw on his return after the services. However, after the procedure, he did not feel a thing. In fact, he was ready to sit on his rickshaw after the stipulated post-operative time and after the team had given him the clearance for discharge. Not only did he ply his vehicle but he also motivated and got two more of his friends within the next 30 minutes to the Community Health Centre (CHC).
