In 2020 we counselled 163,996 clients and served 146,425 clients in over 1,400 sites in 78 districts of Bihar, Rajasthan and Uttar Pradesh, just 3.15% short of what we delivered in 2019. This was possible due to the preparedness of the teams in prioritising client needs, following safety protocols and training our teams virtually in providing services in Covid-19 times.
