



# MINI-CLINICAL OUTREACH TEAM (Mini-COT)

#### Bringing Services Closer to Communities

Foundation for Reproductive Health Services India (FRHS India) is an affiliate of MSI Reproductive Choices. We work towards delivering family planning information and services to women, closer to where they live through Mini-Clinical Outreach Teams (Mini-COTs). Mini-COT is a mobile three-member team which also builds the capacity of the sub-centre Auxiliary Nurse Midwife (ANM) through training, supportive supervision and on-the-job mentoring, so as to enable ANMs to offer services independently.

In 2020, our Mini-COTs left no stone unturned in delivering their services. In the middle of the pandemic, they kept in touch with clients and provided them information and counselling services despite the restrictions.

# Background

Young women and adolescents in rural areas are unable to access family planning and reproductive health as they are less informed and have limited access to Primary Health Centres (PHCs), which may be located far away. The health sub-centres, which are closer to where they live, are often not in a position to offer services due to various constraints such as lack of trained personnel and inadequate equipment.

# How Do Mini-COTs Work?

Mini-COT is a mobile threemember team which is trained and equipped to offer spacing methods of family planning. The team provides services at the health sub-centres which are identified in consultation with the district authorities. On predetermined days, Mini-COTs travel from the headquarters to the identified sub-centres. Community health workers let the local people know about the visit in advance.

#### Services Offered

A Mini-COT offers a basket of reproductive health and family planning services which include:

- Intra Uterine Contraceptive Device (IUCD) insertion and removal (5 years and 10 years)
- Follow-up and referral for IUCD clients
- Family Planning Counselling including post partum family planning counselling
- Emergency Contraceptive Pills
- Referrals for clients who need permanent methods
- Oral Contraceptive Pills
- Condoms
